SAFETY PROCEDURES

- **All rehearsals will be in the Gymnasium space.** Oak will be rehearsing in the Sanctuary post clean up of gym space.
- **Rehearsal access will be through the alleyway Gymnasium doors.** There will be no public access through main doors.
- **All students MUST check in with a staff member at the door** to have their attendance taken upon arrival for contact tracing. Any adult/non-singing participant must register a name and contact number.
- **Please arrive on time** and do not enter the rehearsal space until your ensemble's assigned time and/or once cleaning is done.
- **Hand Sanitizer** will be provided by the choir for students' use before and after rehearsal.
- **Singers will be placed in individual singing "bubble" to maintain 2 metre distance.** No chairs will be provided, unless they are made of solid material able to be sanitized between rehearsals.
- **NO WASHROOM ACCESS, no exceptions.** Students will have access to only one space in the church. Please use the washroom before arriving at rehearsal.
- **NO WATER FOUNTAIN ACCESS, no exceptions.** All students are recommended to **bring a water bottle** in addition to their music folder.
- **No storage space for extra bags.** Students should only bring their **music folder, a water bottle, pencil**, and a **jacket**, all of which will be kept in their individual "bubbles".
- **A Risks and Liabilities Form** must be signed before any minor is able to participate in activities.
